Programs available

Messy Sensory Play	For all ages to engage in important messy sensory play.
Yarning	Join Hellen to explore Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander culture together. All welcome.
Blue Gum Newborns	Come along to learn about the first 1000 days and meet other new parents. For newborns to 8 months and their grown up.
Toddler Time:	A more informal chance to meet other toddler parents and to play together. It is suitable for children around 8 months to 2 years.
Young Parents	This is a special time set aside just for young parents – no other families will be in the Centre during this time.
Being A Parent	A program aims to help parents develop positive communication and parenting skills, emotional literacy, and a tool kit for action.
Shark Cage	This program is designed to empower and heal women who have experienced abuse in their relationships.
Bringing Up Great Kids	BUGK uses mindfulness and reflection to support parents to review and enhance patterns of communication with their children.
Professional Support Services	Our Professional Support Staff have times available for you to meet with them about barriers to learning and school readiness.

CHAPS appointments	Make an appointment to talk to a child health nurse about your child's health or development.
Just Healthy Families	Free women's legal support with the aim of reducing family violence.
Temporary Visa Program	Lawyer who can provide holistic legal support for women on a temporary visa, experiencing or fleeing family violence.
Social Worker	Advice, information & referrals, mental health and well-being promotion, support in groups, community outreach.
School Psychologist	Screening, referrals, consultation & advice, group sessions and information.
Speech Pathologist	Screening, helpful recommendations and strategies, useful information and resources, referrals, support in programs.
WNW Working	Chat to Alyssia about education and employment.
NDIS representative	Discuss early intervention support with NDIS.
Services Australia	Chat with a Services Australia team member for help with Centrelink, medicare and child support payments and services.
Welcome Cultural Services	Person centred supports for people from culturally and linguistically diverse (CaLD) backgrounds and people living with disability
Anglicare	Anglicare's NESTS program can support you in your parenting journey. Come and chat with Rachel.
